

## **A Level Summer Course August 6<sup>th</sup> - 10<sup>th</sup> 2018**

Suitable for Year 12\* students, this five day course will enable confidence and knowledge consolidation to approach Year 13 studies with enthusiasm. This will be particularly important for the more challenging, linear A Levels that have arrived under the recent governmental reforms.

### **The Course**

Students will spend the week focussing on their chosen subject, consolidating their knowledge and improving their exam skills.

Class sizes will be small, with a maximum number of 10 students per class. The teaching will be tailored to the learning needs of the students attending.

Lessons start at 9.15am and run to 4:30pm each day, with three 15 minute breaks and an hour for lunch.

### **Activity Programme**

This will run between 4.30 and 6pm and in the evening, with activities including guidance on the UCAS process, a wellbeing session (coping with exam stress), as well as fun activities such as a BBQ, camp-fire, film night and quiz night\*\*.

There will also be some free time to relax and students will have access to a Games Room. The centre has beautiful grounds with outside areas for football and volleyball too.

### **The Centre**

The centre is located in 15 acres of beautiful green countryside just 45 minutes from the buzz of London and historic Cambridge, close to several small towns and villages. It is also within close range of three major airports, Stansted, Luton and Heathrow.

We recommend that students attend on a residential basis as it allows students to bond and make their stay feel like a good mix of work and fun, enhancing their ability to learn.

Students will stay in the boarding accommodation at the centre – most accommodation is in single rooms. The centre is based in Ware, Hertfordshire with good access from the M25/A10 and from trains direct from London Liverpool Street.

Attendance on a day basis is possible and will include lunch, with pick up at 6pm.

### **Individual Study Needs**

Students will be sent a password to access our Student Portal six weeks before the course. This is an online area where students can highlight any particular topics and areas that they would like to receive help with.

We recommend that students bring their mock/ end of Year 12 exam scripts with them in order to receive feedback and assistance with improving their answers.

### **Cost**

The fully inclusive cost of the course is £1095

If accommodation is not required, the cost is £995.
