INTRODUCTION

Kent College Pembury has followed the Government Guidance, in determining the procedures under which the School Bus Service will operate in September 2021.

The general principles followed are as follows:

- A requirement that those that are ill stay at home
- Robust hand and respiratory hygiene
- Enhanced cleaning arrangements
- Minimise potential for contamination as far as possible.

A set of protocols has been agreed with our external bus providers.

ENHANCED CLEANING ARRANGEMENTS

Buses will be cleaned at the start and end of every journey with particular attention to main contact points.

ROBUST HAND AND RESPIRATORY HYGIENE

Hand sanitiser will be available on each bus and this should be used upon boarding the bus.

Drivers and pupils will be required to wear face coverings. Pupils using school transport are responsible for providing their own face coverings.

MINIMISE POTENTIAL FOR CONTAMINATION AS FAR AS POSSIBLE

In order to maintain consistency of groupings, only pupils whose parents have signed up for the bus service either morning or afternoon will be permitted to use the service, Although ad hoc bus use will be permitted, pupils should still sign up in good time. Pupils will no longer be allocated a specific seat on the bus, however, where possible pupils should sit with others from their year group.

Running of the late bus on either the Sissinghurst or Edenbridge routes will be dependent on the level of demand during the Autumn term.

Pupils waiting to board a bus should continue to maintain an appropriate distance from others, 2 metres where possible.

Pupils will not be permitted to eat on the bus.
