Glossary of acronyms

| EAL | English as an Additional Language: because for some of our students English is their third or even fourth language, this is the term preferred at KC to the more common, 'English as a Second Language'. |

| EAP | English for Academic Purposes: the widely accepted term for courses in which the focus is on the more formal English needed in higher education. |
| JCQ | Joint Council for Qualifications: the body responsible for public exam regulations. |
| SENCo | Special Educational Needs Coordinator |
| IGCSE ESL | International GCSE, English as a Second Language |
| IELTS | International English Language Testing Service: their test of academic English is accepted as an English language qualification for entry to higher education. Some Universities may require an IELTS score in addition to GCSE English. |
| ToEFL | Test of English as a Foreign Language: may be required for entry to American universities or colleges. |
| CEFR | Common European Frame of Reference: European measure of equivalence of foreign language tests. |
